After a successful summer auction in Lyon with some fine results including a world record, Aguttes On Wheels' team has got off to a flying start this autumn! And so the catalogue for our sale on 30 September has taken shape, with a diverse selection of cars to a consistently high standard. 50 cars will come under Maître Aguttes' hammer, among which you will find 20 carefully chosen modern classics, 20 first-rate classic GTs and some 10 rare and exclusive racing cars.



Among our classics from the 1950s, '60s and '70s, we must call out the presence of the unique AC Aceca Bristol chassis number A83/A86, which was owned by Charles Hurlock, the proprietor of the British marque, and then by Sir Antony Richard Pilkington, a famous amateur racing driver and noted collector. A Jaguar XK 150 Coupé in concours condition (estimated at 75,000–95,000 €) is also offered for sale, as well as a pair of Mercedes-Benz 220 SE Coupé and Cabriolet models (est. 25,000–35,000 € and 65,000–85,000 € respectively) and one of the last Citroën SM Maseratis to be built (est. 30,000–40,000 €).

and 1965, it is eligible for major historic track events, while its German registration papers allow it to be used on the road. Another unique model, but this time on account of its unrivalled record in competition, the Porsche 991 GT3 Cup which won the Carrera Cup France three years running (in 2015, 2016 and 2017) will be presented (est. 120,000–150,000 €), alongside the extravagant Chevrolet Corvette Grand Sport which previously competed in the East African Safari Rally (est. 70,000–110,000 €) and the unusual Citroën DS Prototype (est. 5000–15,000 €).



There is also an extensive selection in the category of competition cars, with the notable inclusion of the only AC Cobra 289 MK II FIA built by AC Cars Ltd. in 1996. Identical in every respect to the Cobras produced in 1964

Finally, among the modern classics, top billing is taken by a magnificent Ferrari Testarossa finished in its original Giallo Ferrari, together with a highly exclusive BMW Alpina B10 Biturbo (est. 40,000–60,000 €), two Venturi 260 Cup 511 and Cup 521 models, both with a clear history (est. 40,000–50,000 € and 50,000–65,000 € respectively), as well as some unmissable hot hatches such as the Peugeot 205 GTI 1.6 (est. 8000–13,000 €), Renault Clio Williams (est. 18,000–26,000 €) or Volkswagen Golf GTI Oettinger (est. 35,000–45,000 €)...

Ordered new and delivered to Hollywood, where its first owner was developing his business, it was subsequently bought by Philippe Charbonneaux at the time when his museum was taking

shape! Completely restored between 2012 and 2016, this unique model, a testimony to French expertise in creating exceptional motor cars, is today once again in the spotlight. It will be one of the stars of our next catalogue, alongside a fine collection of French convertibles from the 1970s and the Jaguar Mark 2 which once belonged to Coluche!
